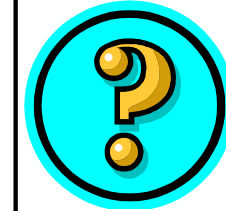

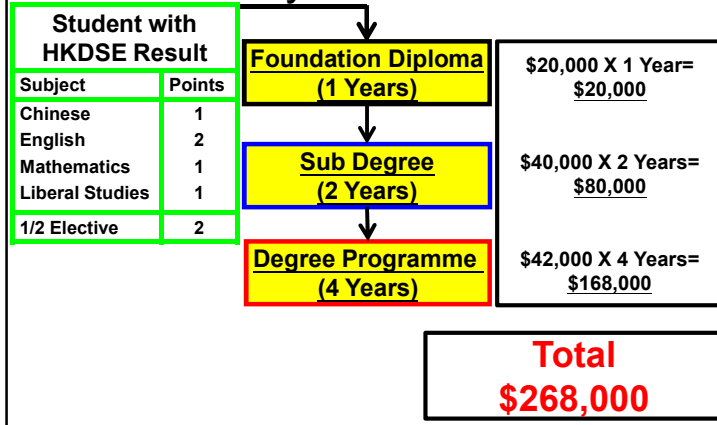

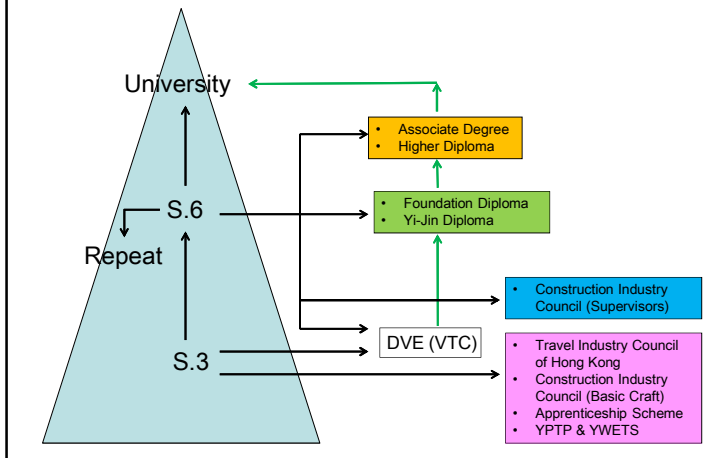

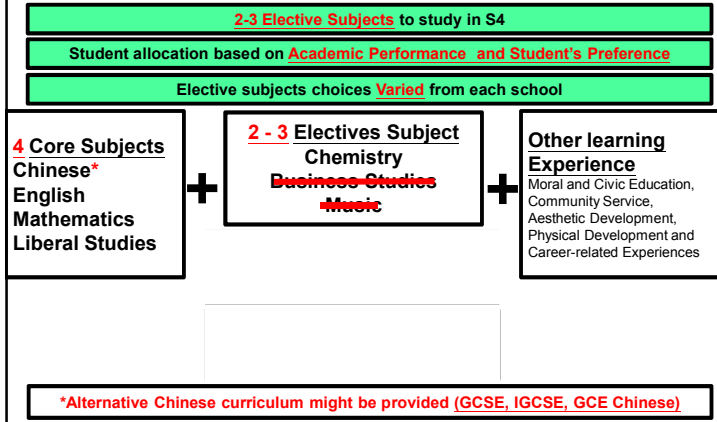
Post-Secondary Education Choices



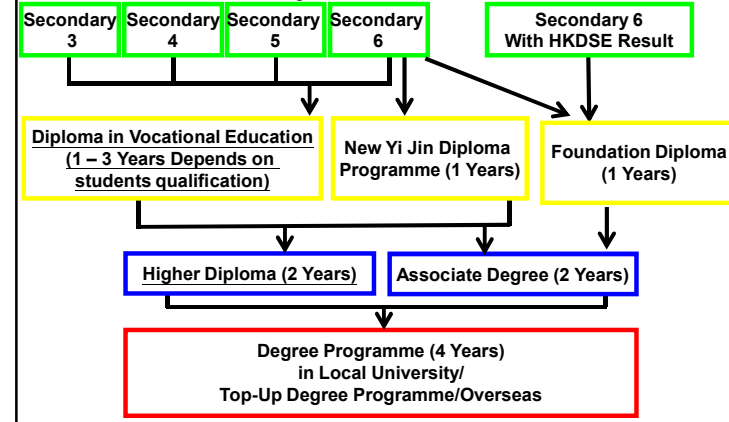
New 3-3-4 Academic Structure
